It seems only a short time ago we were all looking forward to the summer holidays (especially the children and teachers!) and yet here we are approaching the solemn season of Remembrance, remembering all those family members and friends whom we have loved and lost

and then all those who have died in wars as they served our country since 1914. This November sees the 100th anniversary of the ending of the Battle of the Somme and both Remembrance Day and this sombre anniversary are commemorated in Bishopstone. Mobile Phone Mast

Following the request in the last edition of STaB, and on the village website, a number of comments were received about the proposal to site a mobile phone mast at Netton Farm. All of these were in favour of the proposal. The Parish Council has therefore submitted a response to the pre-planning application consultation strongly supporting the project. It is understood that the companies concerned (Vodaphone and O2) intended to submit a planning application by the end of October.

Community Messaging

In the last STaB reference was made to the Police Community Messaging Service. Unfortunately the details were omitted. They are as follows:

The reorganization of policing in our area means that the e-mail system previously provided by PC Pete Jung to those who requested it will no longer operate. However, we are all encouraged to sign up for the Wiltshire and Swindon Community Messaging Service. This provides:

- FREE messages from your local police officers about policing and crime matters in your area.
- Messages by email, text or voicemail.
- You can choose which organisations to receive messages from and the type of information you receive.
- Currently messages are being sent by Wiltshire Police, Wiltshire and Swindon Neighbourhood Watch and Action Fraud. This will soon be extending to include other watch schemes, including Horse and Farm Watch, and potentially partner agencies in the future.
- You can reply to messages from your local officers to help them better police your area, eg by responding to police appeals for information.
- You can also join a neighbourhood Watch scheme in your area or request to start a new one.

People without internet access, but wishing to receive messages by text, can be signed up by a friend or family member on their behalf by visiting the above website. You can also print off and complete a **paper application form** for a friend or family member who does not have internet access and return this to your local police officer, police station or post to:



<u>A reminder of the arrangements for Remembrance Sunday on</u> <u>13th November 2016</u>

The Battle of the Somme took place 100 years ago from July until November 1916. This centenary Act of Remembrance is particularly poignant for us in Bishopstone as we remember the four born in this village, who gave their lives on The Somme:

Private Edgar Dimmer .. 2nd Bn Wiltshire Regiment .. KIA 1 July 1916 .. remembered at Thiepval **Private Robert Webb** .. 2nd Bn Wiltshire Regiment .. died of wounds 5 August 1916 .. remembered at Abbeville

Private Hubert Bryant .. 1st Bn Hampshire Regiment .. KIA 23 October 1916 .. remembered at Thiepval

Private John Dibben .. 32nd Bn Australian Infantry .. KIA 1 November 1916 .. remembered at Flers

Our Service of Remembrance will start at 1050 a.m. on Sunday 13th November in our church.

THE BATTLE OF THE SOMME

The Battle of the Somme lasted from 1 July 1916 until 18 November 1916. While the first day of the battle is infamous in the annals of military history, less is known of the actions that occurred in the following months.

The illustrated talk will cover background to the decision to attack at the Somme, the opening of the battle and why the British Army was decimated in the first few hours, the failure of intelligence and artillery, the effects on the towns and cities of Great Britain, Ireland and the Commonwealth and the subsequent actions that eventually seized some ground from the Germans before winter set in.




