Twenty four people attended the Defibrillator Awareness session provided by the Community Heartbeat Trust in the Village Hall on 15^{th} June. Many thanks to all those who came along. Their feedback was very positive and if there is sufficient demand for another session the Parish Council will try to arrange this. If you are interested please let me know. In the meantime – if you are going to have a cardiac arrest, do so in Croucheston, because that part of the village was best represented at the meeting!

In the meantime, if you want to know more about the use of defibrillators just Google "London Ambulance Service Defibrillator demonstration on You Tube". Our defibrillator is different to that used in the video in that it is fully automatic, you don't have to turn it on or press any buttons, but the video provides a good general guide.

I have been asked about the new mobile phone mast. At the time of writing

it was still unclear when the new mast will "go live", but it may have done so by the time you read this! The mast is a joint venture between Vodafone and O2 - so it will be the users of those suppliers who will benefit.


FOOTPATHS AND BRIDLEWAYS

It is particularly important that landowners check their paths and bridleways at this time of year when maximum growth of vegetation is taking place. 
