

BISHOPSTONE PARISH COUNCIL

The next meeting of the Parish Council will be on Thursday 12th March 2015 after the Annual Parish Meeting (see separate notice). All are welcome to attend both meetings.

In the meantime:

the latest information about the high speed broadband project is that the overhead work to the roadside poles between Broad Chalke and Bishopstone is complete and work to connect the fibre optic cable to the new cabinet opposite Flamstone Street has begun. No "go live" date is yet available but it could be only a matter of weeks after you read this.

A letter has been sent to the Wiltshire Police and Crime Commissioner about establishing a Community Speed Watch in Bishopstone. A reply has yet to be received.

As you may have seen in the press, Wiltshire Council, having previously decided that a 3 month suspension would give them the necessary savings on the Green Bin collection, have instead decided to charge £40 per bin in the coming financial year.

The C12 (Broad Chalke Road/High Road) is to be the subject of complete re-surfacing in the 2015/16 Highways Programme. There is no date set for when this will take place. There will be some, inevitable, disruption.

Wiltshire Council is also making savings to the mobile library service, with fewer stops in those villages that have more than one. Bishopstone only has one (in The Styles) but the message is clear - use it or lose it!

The Cycle Wiltshire Grand Prix will again be coming through the village this year - on Sunday 10th May. This elite cycle race, part of the British Cycling National Road Race series, will see about 100 elite riders from top professional teams taking part.

Did You Know



(Notes from the PCC)

Much progress has been made with building repairs to the church, since our last notes. Work has been completed on the tower windows and on the external walls to reduce the action of damp and weather. The medieval window in the vestry is to be moved to the window of the south transept so that it can be enjoyed by all. This is a costly exercise and will take time to complete. The plinth in the south transept has been repaired and the piscine is awaiting its turn.

Plans are going ahead to improve the heating and to replace the light bulbs in the nave. Both projects are difficult to complete due to the height of the lights and the wood in the church which might be affected by too much heat!! Hopes remain high for more comfort in future!

A thorough examination of the bells in the tower resulted in a full report. They are all old and cracked and cannot be rung full-circle, as the frames are worm-eaten and broken. The cost of rehanging and retuning will be excessive, and so only one can be tolled to announce the start of the services. Each bell is dedicated individually and was installed at different date:

‘In God is my Hope’ dated 1583

‘God be our Guide’ in 1587, and

‘Edward Hayerd: Edward King’ dated 1652. There is even room for a fourth bell!

Once again, the church is well worth a visit, to see the repairs and care taken to keep it open, and to join us for one of the many services.







We have been cycling for a while after buying new bikes last year, and deciding that exercise is good for a person, so we have been making a nuisance of ourselves to the drivers of vehicles up and down the Chalke Valley with our maniac riding about I am sure (sorry about that).

So we decided it would be a good idea to do something for others.

There is a charity cycle ride from London to Paris in July of this year finishing on the 26th, (not the Tour de France) and we have signed on to ride it on behalf of the Alzheimer's Society.
