



The League of Friends of Salisbury Hospital is 60 years old!

The League of Friends was formed in 1954, as the result of a public meeting held in Salisbury Guildhall under the chairmanship of Councillor Hedley Annetts, Mayor of Salisbury.

During the chairmanship of Ray Annetts, who served 30 years in that role, the League embarked on two major building projects as well as continuing to provide help and support for patients, relatives and staff year by year.

In 1979, to mark its silver anniversary, the League of Friends funded a bungalow for use by relatives of patients.

In 1994, to meet increasing demand for places, a second bungalow was built, again funded by the League of Friends.

Over the years, these bungalows have provided a much need resource and respite for families at a particularly stressful time in their lives.

Now, in its Diamond Year of supporting Salisbury's hospitals, The League of Friends has embarked on a major project to refurbish both bungalows, which will cost £200,000.

The Trustees of the League of Friends have committed substantial funds towards the project, but are seeking to raise £120,000, through sponsorship, donations and other fundraising activities, to ensure that the total cost, of both building work and the purchase of new furniture, is met. A successful outcome will also ensure that funds remain available to enable the Trustees to continue to support requests from hospital departments for equipment and resources, which will enhance the experience of patients and their families.

When the refurbishment has been completed, the bungalows will be renamed: Annetts House and Batten House, in recognition of the enormous contribution made, particularly by Ray and Gladys Annetts and Elizabeth Batten, our President, who is a founder member of the League – and still going strong!

Please help us raise funds for this essential work to a much appreciated and much used facility.



BISHOPSTONE PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

Speeding

The Parish Council failed to persuade the South West Board of Wiltshire Council that studies should be done on whether to introduce 20mph speed limits in the village “back lanes”. The matter will be reconsidered at a future meeting of the Parish Council because it is now clear that if mean existing average traffic speeds are in excess of 24mph, any limit will only be introduced if there are also “traffic calming” measures such as Chicanes etc. If these are included there has to be street lighting. The cost of any such scheme is likely to be prohibitive and not everyone would support the introduction of street lighting in the village.

On the other hand the Wiltshire Police and Crime Commissioner has finally approved the introduction of a Community Speed Watch in the village. This means it will be possible to monitor the speed of vehicles along the High Road past Whitlock Rise and Meadow View. Drivers who significantly exceed the 30mph limit will be contacted by the police. Councillor John Gibbon is setting up the team to carry out CSW monitoring and arranging training – see separate item in this STaB.

Faulston Barns

At the end of March Wiltshire Council granted planning permission for the conversion of Faulston Barns into six houses. The approval is subject to a range of conditions (including a requirement for a full archeological survey, a scheme of sustainable surface water drainage, provision and safeguarding of bat, swallow and barn owl roosts and provision of visibility splays at the entrance along Faulston Lane). Whilst some preparatory work may begin soon, main construction is unlikely to begin before September. Discussions are taking place with the developers about the routing of construction traffic in the village. The permission is subject to a legal agreement that will ensure the developers provide a financial contribution towards village recreation and amenity projects.

Broadband



If availability is confirmed you will need to contact your ISP (broadband supplier) to sign up for their high speed service.
